You <b>were</b> (você era ou estava)	Were you?
He <b>was</b> (ele era ou estava)	Was he?
She <b>was</b> (ela era ou estava)	Was she?
It <b>was</b> (ele, ela era ou estava)	Was it?
We <b>were</b> (nós éramos ou estávamos)	Were we?
You <b>were</b> (vocês eram ou estavam)	Were you?
They <b>were</b> (eles eram ou estavam)	Were they?

Agora vamos ver o verbo to be no passado na forma negativa:

Negative form	Forma contraída
I was not at home yesterday.	I wasn't
You were not	You weren't
He was not	He wasn't
She was not	She wasn't
It was not	It wasn't
We were not	We weren't
You were not	You weren't
They were not	They weren't
