## ATIVIDADES DE APRENDIZAGEM

**Tema :** Simple Future Tense

*Mr. Lazy's week*



Nancy – What **will** you **do** next week?

Adam – Well. On Monday I **will not to work** because I **will be** very tired.

On Sunday I practice some sports.

Nancy – And what about Wednesday?

Adam – I **won't work** because I have to go to the doctor. I am not well...

I am working too much.!

Nancy – And the others days?

Adam – Friday is almost the end of the week. So I **will stay** at home and I **will rest**.

Bem você observou no diálogo acima, que na próxima semana Mr. Lazy fará ou não algumas atividades. Vamos aprender agora como se forma o futuro – (future tense), em Inglês:

- Acrescentamos o auxiliar **will** antes do infinitivo do verbo principal, para todas as pessoas.

Affirmative form	Contracted form	Tradução
I will work	I'll work	Eu trabalharei
You will work	You'll work	Você trabalhará
He will work	He'll work	Ele trabalhará
She will work	She'll work	Ela trabalhará
We will work	We'll work	Nós trabalharemos
You will work	You'll work	Vocês trabalharão
They will work	They'll work	Eles/elas trabalharão

- We **will** be at home tomorrow. – Nós estaremos em casa amanhã.  
 She **will study** next week. – Ela estudará na próxima semana.  
 I **will sell** the car on Thursday. – Eu venderei o carro na quinta-feira.  
 He **will go** to Miami next month. – Ele irá para Miami no próximo mês.  
 They **will buy** the magazine after tomorrow. – Eles comprarão a revista depois de amanhã.

Vejamos agora como fica:

- **A forma interrogativa**, e você, meu caro aluno, deve estar lembrado que o verbo vem antes do pronome pessoal:
- **A forma negativa** – acrescenta-se a partícula de negação not entre o verbo auxiliar e o verbo no infinitivo:

Interrogative form	Negative form	Contract form
Will I work?	I will not work	I won't
Will you work?	You will not work	You won't
Will he work?	He will not work	He won't
Will she work?	She will not work	She won't
Will we work?	We will not work	We won't
Will you work?	You will not work	You won't
Will they work?	They will not work	They won't
