PREPOSITIONS

As **preposições em inglês** (*prepositions*) são termos que funcionam como conectivos das orações. São muito importantes para conectar as palavras de uma frase sejam substantivos ou pronomes, estabelecendo uma ligação entre elas. Sendo assim, as preposições completam o sentido das frases.

Significados das preposições

As principais e mais utilizadas preposições em inglês são:

- **In** - dependendo do contexto pode significar: dentro de; em; de; no e na.
- **On** - dependendo do contexto pode significar: sobre a; em cima de; acima de; em; no; na.
- **At** - dependendo do contexto pode significar: à; em; na; no.

USOS

Prepositions of Place - AT

- Nos usamos **"at"** para nos referirmos a lugares que pensamos como um ponto de referência, ou um evento onde há um grupo de pessoas, por exemplo.

Specific addresses	At the school
At class	At work
At home	At the door
At the library	At the the church
At the office	At a friend's house

Prepositions of Time - At

- Nos usamos **"at"** para designar um tempo específico (hora) e em algumas expressões como:

At 3 o'clock	At weekends
At noon	At sunrise
At dinnertime	At sunset
At bedtime	At Christmas
At night	At the moment

Prepositions of Place - In

- Nos usamos "in" para nos referirmos a coisas ou lugares que estão fechados ou cercados e também para nomes de locais como cidade, estados, condados, países e continentes.

In a garden	In Connecticut
In a bedroom	In class
In a taxi	In the library
In a flat	In America
In Vegas	In a plane

Prepositions of Time - In

- Nos usamos "in" para meses, anos, estações, séculos ou em alguns períodos de tempo específicos:

In the morning	In 20th century
In the afternoon	In July
In the evening	In the Ice Age
In winter	In the past
In 1977	In the future

Prepositions of Place - On

- Nos usamos "on" para nos referirmos a nomes de ruas e avenidas ou para demonstrar posições em superfícies horizontais e verticais.

On the box	On road 66
On the wall	On the grass
On fifth street	On the blackboard
On the roof	On page
On Ocean Avenue	On the horse

Prepositions of Time - On

- Nos usamos "on" para dias da semana, meses + dias, datas completas e feriados específicos seguidos das palavras "day" e "eve"

On Sunday
On 17 July
On 17 July 1977
On my birthday
On New Year's Eve
On Christmas Day

Prepositions of Time

AT - ON - IN



AT

- Specific Time** - I wake up at 7 o'clock.
- She returned home at midnight.
- Holiday Period** - Everyone seems happy at Christmas.

ON

- Days of the week** - We will visit you on Wednesday.
- Specific days** - I return to my country on the 27th.
- Dates** - We get together on Christmas Day.

IN

- Months** - My birthday is in January.
- Years** - America was discovered in 1492.
- Seasons** - I always go to the beach in summer.
- Length of Time** - It will be ready in 20 minutes.
- Centuries** - Life was different in the 15th century.

Parts of the day

- IN the morning** - I go to the gym in the morning.
- IN the afternoon** - I often feel tired in the afternoon.
- IN the evening** - I study English in the evening.
- AT night** - I like to read in bed at night.

ON + Day + Part of the day

- We will have a party on Friday night.
- Our flight leaves on Monday morning.

PREPOSITIONS OF TIME : IN - ON - AT



AT We use "at" to express a precise time

- at 5 o'clock
- at 11:30 pm
- at lunchtime
- at the moment
- at midnight
- at sunrise
- at sunset

ON We use "on" before days and dates.

- on Friday
- on Mondays
- on 4 July
- on 17 March 1966
- on Children's Day
- on his birthday
- on Mother's Day

IN We use "in" before months, years, centuries and long period of time.

- in November
- in winter
- in 2001
- in the 20th century
- in Stone Age
